Twenty-Five (25) appear only once. 10 in the Book of Matthew, 1 in the Book of Mark, and 14 in the Book of Luke. —Randy Fagg

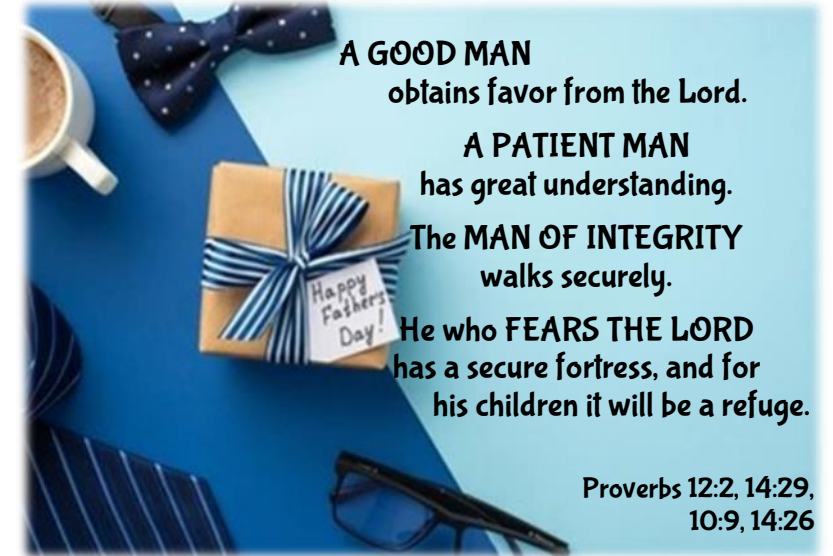
